



Notice to Constituents and Other Interested Parties

Chatham University's Nursing Programs (RN-BSN, MSN, and DNP) are currently preparing for the reaccreditation process with the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). The on-site evaluation is scheduled for 3/18/2019 – 3/20/2019. As part of the CCNE accreditation process, there is opportunity for program constituents (e.g., faculty teaching in, students enrolled in the program(s) under review) and other interested parties to submit, in writing, comments concerning the program's qualification for accreditation.

At least two months prior to the scheduled on-site evaluation, Chatham University's Nursing Programs is required to notify the constituents of the upcoming reaccreditation visit. Written third-party comments must be received by CCNE 21 days before the scheduled on-site evaluation, by February 25, 2019. All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English.
