THE UNIVERSITY SATISFIED ITS MUST OR SHALL SPEND PROVISIONS OF INDIVIDUAL ENDOWMENT AGREEMENTS THROUGH THE USE OF UNRESTRICTED OPERATING FUNDS. THE UNIVERSITY BELIEVES THAT THIS SPENDING POLICY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA'S GUIDELINES AND WITH THE UNIVERSITY'S OBJECTIVE TO MAINTAIN THE PURCHASING POWER OF THE ENDOWMENT ASSETS HELD IN PERPETUITY, AS WELL AS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REAL GROWTH THROUGH NEW GIFTS AND INVESTMENT RETURN.
